Year 9 iMedia Overview

During Year 9 iMedia, students will identify and use different pre-production documents in different areas. Students will create different multimedia products, utilising different pre-production documents in the process. They will also look at different concepts which are addressed in different units during the GCSE iMedia course.

Unit Title	Unit Overview
Pre-Production Documents	Students will look at Pre-Production Documents and identify their uses and create different Pre-Production Documents for given scenarios.
Causeway School Promotional Video	Students will be creating a Causeway School Promotional Video during the course of this unit. They will use different pre-production documents to plan it, prior to creation.
Advanced Photoshop Techniques	Students will create different media using advanced Photoshop techniques, responding to a brief they have been given. They will have to plan and create their product and discuss how they have fulfilled the requirements given to them.
Introduction to Website Design	This unit will see students given an introduction to Website Design. They will look at different concepts and ideas relating to website design before creating a simple four page website, which will be published online.
What makes a Comic Book	Students will identify and describe what makes a Comic Book, both in terms of content and layout, as well as characters within them. They will then create a simple comic book story, based on a brief given to them.
Why are digital graphics used	Students will begin their first piece of Controlled Assessment work, looking at how and why digital graphics are used in different industries.
