British Library Trip London – Tuesday 22nd January 2019



Dear Parent

We have arranged an incredible opportunity for students. We are offering a trip to attend two workshops at the British Library in London. This is a great opportunity for students to experience one of the world's leading institutions. The British Library will provide two workshops for our students:

1. 10:30 – 12:00 Questioning Texts
2. 1:00-2:30pm Exploring English

Attendance on this trip will clearly be very helpful in developing responses for GCSE English.

The students will need to come to school at 7:15am and make their way to the student entrance where they will meet Mr Hill. We will travel to London by coach and depart Causeway at 7:30am. We will arrive at the British Library at 10:00 and remain there until 3:00pm when we will then depart and make our way back to Causeway. We aim to be back at Causeway by 6:00pm.

Students will need to be in full school uniform for the trip and bring a packed lunch. They are welcome to bring spending money, I recommend no more than £20. If they choose to bring electronic devices for the journey please be aware that these are their responsibility, the school cannot take responsibility for any damage or any lost devices. If your child suffers with travel sickness please ensure they have taken medication for this.

For this trip we are asking for a contribution of £20. We would then ask that the remaining £10 be paid by Friday 16 November. We only have a limited number of seats available so this will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
