9am exam procedure:

- All tutors to register their tutor groups.
- Tutors to bring students down to the atrium **at 8.45am**
- Students to line up in their seating plan rows in the atrium in silence.
- Tutors to stand between students to help ensure silence.
- Head of KS4 to be present at the start of exams.
- Subject specialist will give a talk before they walk to the main hall.
- Students will walk in silence to the exam hall.

1 pm exam procedure:

- Students **must attend lesson 3** and **leave at 12.15pm** to go to lunch.
- Teachers to round students up so they are at the atrium by **12.45pm**
- Students to line up in their seating plan rows in the atrium in silence.
- Lesson 4 teachers to stand between students to help ensure silence.
- Subject specialist will give a talk before they walk to the main hall.
- Students will walk in silence to the exam hall.

Students must attend normal lessons if they do not take that option subject.

All students will be Q coded on the registers if they should be in an exam. If any students turn up to your lesson and there is a Q code please send them immediately to the main hall.

Access students will take their exams in the access room on the first floor next to Art.

Please ensure that students are prepared for these mocks and understand their importance in showing progress and to allow us to provide feedback for them to continue to make progress towards their target grades.

Remind students that they must bring their own equipment to the exams, including a calculator.
